## A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to allow for advertising relating to certain activities in compliance with State law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Marijuana Advertising  
5 in Legal States Act of 2016” or the “MAILS Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

7 Section 403(c)(1) of the Controlled Substances Act  
8 (21 U.S.C. 843(c)(1)) is amended by adding at the end  
9 the following: “This paragraph does not apply to an adver-

1 tisement to the extent that the advertisement relates to  
2 an activity, involving marihuana, that is in compliance  
3 with the law of the State in which that activity takes  
4 place.”.
