3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping Mass Hack-
5 ing Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL PROCEDURE RULES.**

7 The proposed amendments to rule 41 of the Federal
8 Rules of Criminal Procedure, which are set forth in the

1 order entered by the Supreme Court of the United States
2 on April 28, 2016, shall not take effect.
