Mr. DAINES (for himself, Mr. MORAN, Mr. ROBERTS, and Mr. SCOTT) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

## A BILL

To prohibit the transfer of any individual detained at United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ANY TRANSFER OF ANY INDI-**  
4 **VIDUAL DETAINED AT UNITED STATES NAVAL**  
5 **STATION, GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—No amounts authorized to be ap-  
7 propriated or otherwise available for any department or  
8 agency of the United States Government may be used dur-  
9 ing the period specified in subsection (b) to transfer, re-  
10 lease, or assist in the transfer or release to or within the

1 United States, its territories, or possessions, or to any for-  
2 eign country or entity, of any individual detained at Guan-  
3 tanamo.

4 (b) SPECIFIED PERIOD.—The period specified in this  
5 subsection is the period that—

6 (1) begins on the date of the enactment of this  
7 Act; and

8 (2) ends on the earlier of—

9 (A) the date of the enactment of an Act  
10 authorizing appropriations for military activities  
11 of the Department of Defense for fiscal year  
12 2017; or

13 (B) January 1, 2017.

14 (c) INDIVIDUAL DETAINED AT GUANTANAMO DE-  
15 FINED.—In this section, the term “individual detained at  
16 Guantanamo” means an individual located at United  
17 States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, as of Octo-  
18 ber 1, 2009, who—

19 (1) is not a national of the United States (as  
20 defined in section 101(a)(22) of the Immigration  
21 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(22)) or a  
22 member of the Armed Forces of the United States;  
23 and

24 (2) is—

1 (A) in the custody or under the control of  
2 the Department of Defense; or

3 (B) otherwise detained at United States  
4 Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay.
