Mr. PAUL introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to
the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To repeal the Military Selective Service Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Muhammad Ali Vol-
5 untary Service Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Military Selective Service Act
8 (50 U.S.C. 3801 et seq.) is repealed.

9 (b) TRANSFERS IN CONNECTION WITH REPEAL.—
10 Notwithstanding the proviso in section 10(a)(4) of the
11 Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. 3809(a)(4)), the
12 Office of Selective Service Records shall not be reestab-

1 lished after the repeal of the Military Selective Service
2 Act. Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the assets, contracts, property, and
4 records held by the Selective Service System, and the un-
5 expended balances of any appropriations available to the
6 Selective Service System, shall be transferred to the Ad-
7 ministrator of General Services. The Director of the Office
8 of Personnel Management shall assist officers and employ-
9 ees of the Selective Service System to transfer to other
10 positions in the executive branch.

11 (c) EFFECT ON EXISTING SANCTIONS.—Notwith-
12 standing any other provision of law, a person may not be
13 denied a right, privilege, benefit, or employment position
14 under Federal law on the grounds that the person failed
15 to present himself for and submit to registration under
16 section 3 of the Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C.
17 3802) before the repeal of that Act by subsection (a).
