3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Invest-
5 ment Capital Company Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASED LIMITATIONS ON LEVERAGE FOR MUL-**
2 **TIPLE LICENSES UNDER COMMON CONTROL.**

3 Section 303(b)(2) of the Small Business Investment
4 Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 683(b)(2)(B)) is amended by
5 striking “\$225,000,000” and inserting “\$350,000,000”.
