A BILL

To amend the Small Business Investment Act of 1958 to provide for increased limitations on leverage for multiple licenses under common control.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Invest-
5 ment Capital Company Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASED LIMITATIONS ON LEVERAGE FOR MUL-**
2 **TIPLE LICENSES UNDER COMMON CONTROL.**

3 Section 303(b)(2) (*B*) of the Small Business Invest-
4 ment Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 683(b)(2)(B)) is amended
5 by striking “\$225,000,000” and inserting
6 “\$350,000,000”.

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
