- 7 Printing may direct, in consultation with the Clerk of the
- 8 House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.
- 9 (c) Number of Copies.—In addition to the usual
- 10 number of copies, there shall be printed for the use of the
- 11 Architect of the Capitol the lesser of—
- 12 (1) 5,000 copies of the book printed under this
- 13 section; or
- 14 (2) such number of copies of the book as does
- not exceed a total production and printing cost of
- 16 \$400,000.
