Mr. WILSON of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence

A BILL

To direct the Director of National Intelligence to conduct a study on cyber attack standards of measurement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cyber Attack Stand-
5 ards of Measurement Study”.

6 **SEC. 2. CYBER ATTACK STANDARDS OF MEASUREMENT**
7 **STUDY.**

8 (a) **STUDY REQUIRED.**—The Director of National In-
9 telligence, in consultation with the Secretary of Homeland
10 Security, the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investiga-

tion, and the Secretary of Defense, shall carry out a study to determine appropriate standards that—

(1) can be used to measure the damage of cyber incidents for the purposes of determining the response to such incidents; and

(2) include a method for quantifying the damage caused to affected computers, systems, and devices.

(b) REPORTS TO CONGRESS.—

(1) PRELIMINARY FINDINGS.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National Intelligence shall provide to the Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs, and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate and the Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on Homeland Security, and the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of Representatives the initial findings of the study required under subsection (a).

(2) REPORT.—Not later than 360 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National Intelligence shall submit to the Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs, and the Se-

2 Committee on Armed Services, the Committee on
3 Homeland Security, and the Permanent Select Com-
4 mittee on Intelligence of the House of Representa-
5 tives a report containing the complete findings of
6 such study.

7 (3) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by
8 paragraph (2) shall be submitted in unclassified
9 form, but may contain a classified annex.

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
