AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out a pilot program to provide access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “No Hero Left Un-
3 treated Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

5 Congress finds the following:

6 (1) Magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance ther-
7 apy has successfully treated more than 400 veterans
8 with post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain
9 injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and
10 opiate addiction.

11 (2) Recent clinical trials and randomized, pla-
12 cebo-controlled, double-blind studies have produced
13 promising measurable outcomes in the evolution of
14 magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy.

15 (3) The outcomes described in paragraph (2)
16 have resulted in escalating demand from returning
17 members of the Armed Forces and veterans who are
18 seeking access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided reso-
19 nance therapy.

20 (4) Congress recognizes the importance of initi-
21 ating innovative pilot programs that demonstrate the
22 use and effectiveness of new treatment options for
23 post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain in-
24 jury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and opi-
25 ate addiction.

1 **SEC. 3. MAGNETIC EEG/EKG-GUIDED RESONANCE THERAPY**
2 **PILOT PROGRAM.**

3 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—Commencing not later than
4 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
5 Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall carry out a pilot pro-
6 gram to provide access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided res-
7 onance therapy to treat veterans suffering from post-trau-
8 matic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sex-
9 ual trauma, chronic pain, or opiate addiction.

10 (b) LOCATIONS.—The Secretary shall carry out the
11 pilot program under subsection (a) at not more than two
12 facilities of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

13 (c) PARTICIPANTS.—In carrying out the pilot pro-
14 gram under subsection (a), the Secretary shall provide ac-
15 cess to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to
16 not more than 50 veterans.

17 (d) DURATION.—The Secretary shall carry out the
18 pilot program under subsection (a) for a 1-year period.

19 (e) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the termi-
20 nation of the pilot program under subsection (d), the Sec-
21 retary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
22 of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of
23 the House of Representatives a report on the pilot pro-
24 gram.

25 (f) NO AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—No
26 additional amounts are authorized to be appropriated to

1 carry out the requirements of this section. Such require-
2 ments shall be carried out using amounts authorized
3 under provisions of law other than this section.
