### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Veterans 2nd Amend-
- 3 ment Protection Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. CONDITIONS FOR TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PER-
- 5 SONS AS ADJUDICATED MENTALLY INCOM-
- 6 PETENT FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 55 of title 38, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 5501A
- 9 the following new section:
- 10 "§ 5501B. Conditions for treatment of certain persons
- as adjudicated mentally incompetent for
- 12 **certain purposes**
- "Notwithstanding any determination made by the
- 14 Secretary under section 5501A of this title, in any case
- 15 arising out of the administration by the Secretary of laws
- 16 and benefits under this title, a person who is mentally in-
- 17 capacitated, deemed mentally incompetent, or experi-
- 18 encing an extended loss of consciousness shall not be con-
- 19 sidered adjudicated as a mental defective under subsection
- 20 (d)(4) or (g)(4) of section 922 of title 18 without the order
- 21 or finding of a judge, magistrate, or other judicial author-
- 22 ity of competent jurisdiction that such person is a danger
- 23 to himself or herself or others.".
- 24 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 25 at the beginning of chapter 55 of such title is amended

- 1 by inserting after the item relating to section 5501A the
- 2 following new item:

"5501B. Conditions for treatment of certain persons as adjudicated mentally incompetent for certain purposes.".
