## A BILL

To repeal the renewable fuel program of the Environmental Protection Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Renewable Fuel Stand-  
3 ard Elimination Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RENEWABLE FUEL PROGRAM.**

5       Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.  
6 7545(o)) is repealed.
