1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Assuring Law Enforce-
3 ment Requests Are Timely Evaluated by the Department
4 of Homeland Security Act of 2017” or the “ALERTED
5 Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF ISSUANCE OF DETAINER.**

7 Section 287(d) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1357(d)) is amended in the matter pre-
9 ceding paragraph (1), by striking “relating to controlled
10 substances”.
