A BILL

To require the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to complete a study on the human health implications of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination in drinking water.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Investing in Testing
5 Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. STUDY BY CDC ON HEALTH IMPLICATIONS OF PER-**
2 **AND POLYFLUOROALKYL SUBSTANCES CON-**
3 **TAMINATION IN DRINKING WATER.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Director of the Centers for
5 Disease Control and Prevention shall—

6 (1) not later than 60 days after the date of en-
7 actment of this Act, commence a study on the
8 human health implications of per- and
9 polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination in
10 drinking water; and

11 (2) not later than 2 years and 60 days after the
12 date of enactment of this Act—

13 (A) complete such study; and

14 (B) submit a report to the Congress on the
15 results of such study.

16 (b) **AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**—To carry
17 out this Act, there is authorized to be appropriated
18 \$15,000,000.

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
