A BILL

To amend the Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990 to provide for a macadamia tree health initiative, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Macadamia Tree
5 Health Initiative”.

6 **SEC. 2. MACADAMIA TREE HEALTH INITIATIVE.**

7 Section 1672(d) of the Food, Agriculture, Conserva-
8 tion, and Trade Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 5925(d)) is amend-
9 ed by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

1 “(11) MACADAMIA TREE HEALTH INITIATIVE.—

2 Research and extension grants may be made under

3 this section for the purposes of—

4 “(A) developing and disseminating science-

5 based tools and treatments to combat the maca-

6 damia felted coccid (*Eriococcus ironsidei*); and

7 “(B) establishing an areawide integrated

8 pest management program in areas affected by,

9 or areas at risk of being affected by, the maca-

10 damia felted coccid.”.

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
