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## AN ACT

To amend the National Law Enforcement Museum Act to allow the Museum to acquire, receive, possess, collect, ship, transport, import, and display firearms, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “National Law Enforce-  
3 ment Museum Exhibits Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT MU-**  
5 **SEUM TO ACQUIRE, RECEIVE, POSSESS, COL-**  
6 **LECT, SHIP, TRANSPORT, IMPORT, AND DIS-**  
7 **PLAY FIREARMS.**

8       The National Law Enforcement Museum Act (Public  
9 Law 106–492) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
10 lowing:

11 **“SEC. 5. AUTHORITY OF MUSEUM TO ACQUIRE, RECEIVE,**  
12 **POSSESS, COLLECT, SHIP, TRANSPORT, IM-**  
13 **PORT, AND DISPLAY FIREARMS.**

14       “(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
15 vision of Federal law, or any law or any rule or regulations  
16 of a State or any political subdivision thereof, the Museum  
17 may acquire, receive, possess, collect, ship, transport, im-  
18 port, and display firearms (as defined in section 921(a)(3)  
19 of title 18, United States Code, or section 5845(a) of the  
20 Internal Revenue Code of 1986) in fulfilling the purposes  
21 of the Museum.

22       “(b) DEFINITION OF STATE.—In subsection (a), the  
23 term ‘State’ means the several States, the District of Co-  
24 lumbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands,  
25 Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Is-

1 lands, American Samoa, and the possessions of the United  
2 States.”.
