AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of Energy to review and update
a report on the energy and environmental benefits of
the re-refining of used lubricating oil.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ENERGY SAVINGS FROM LUBRICATING OIL.**

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
3 of this Act, the Secretary of Energy, in cooperation with
4 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-
5 cy and the Director of the Office of Management and
6 Budget, shall—

7 (1) review and update the report prepared pur-
8 suant to section 1838 of the Energy Policy Act of
9 2005;

10 (2) after consultation with relevant Federal,
11 State, and local agencies and affected industry and
12 stakeholder groups, update data that was used in
13 preparing that report; and

14 (3) prepare and submit to Congress a coordi-
15 nated Federal strategy to increase the beneficial
16 reuse of used lubricating oil, that—

17 (A) is consistent with national policy as es-
18 tablished pursuant to section 2 of the Used Oil
19 Recycling Act of 1980 (Public Law 96–463);
20 and

21 (B) addresses measures needed to—

22 (i) increase the responsible collection
23 of used oil;

24 (ii) disseminate public information
25 concerning sustainable reuse options for
26 used oil; and

1 (iii) promote sustainable reuse of used
2 oil by Federal agencies, recipients of Fed-
3 eral grant funds, entities contracting with
4 the Federal Government, and the general
5 public.
