A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Project Act of 1939 to authorize pumped storage hydropower development utilizing multiple Bureau of Reclamation reservoirs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Bureau of Reclamation*
5 *Pumped Storage Hydropower Development Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY FOR PUMPED STORAGE HYDROPOWER**
7 **DEVELOPMENT UTILIZING MULTIPLE BU-**
8 **REAU OF RECLAMATION RESERVOIRS.**

9 *Section 9(c)(1) of the Reclamation Project Act of 1939*
10 *(43 U.S.C. 485h(c)(1)) is amended by inserting “and*
11 *pumped storage hydropower development exclusively uti-*
12 *lizing Bureau of Reclamation reservoirs” after “including*
13 *small conduit hydropower development”.*

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
