A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to include as part of the buildings and grounds of the National Gallery of Art any buildings and other areas within the boundaries of any real estate or other property interests acquired by the National Gallery of Art.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF BUILDINGS AND OTHER AREAS**
2 **WITHIN BOUNDARIES OF REAL ESTATE OR**
3 **OTHER PROPERTY INTERESTS ACQUIRED BY**
4 **NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART.**

5 Section 6301(2) of title 40, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
8 by striking “The National Gallery of Art” and in-
9 serting “(A) The National Gallery of Art”;

10 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (A), (B),
11 and (C) as clauses (i), (ii), and (iii), respectively;
12 and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
14 paragraph:

15 “(B) All other buildings, service roads,
16 walks, and other areas within the exterior
17 boundaries of any real estate or land or interest
18 in land (including temporary use) that the Na-
19 tional Gallery of Art acquires and that the Di-
20 rector of the National Gallery of Art determines
21 to be necessary for the adequate protection of
22 individuals or property in the National Gallery
23 of Art and suitable for administration as a part
24 of the National Gallery of Art.”.
