AN ACT

To authorize the expansion of an existing hydroelectric
project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TERROR LAKE HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT**
2 **UPPER HIDDEN BASIN DIVERSION AUTHOR-**
3 **IZATION.**

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) COMMISSION.—The term “Commission”
6 means the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

7 (2) TERROR LAKE HYDROELECTRIC
8 PROJECT.—The term “Terror Lake Hydroelectric
9 Project” means the project identified in section 1325
10 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation
11 Act (16 U.S.C. 3212), and which is Federal Energy
12 Regulatory Commission project number 2743.

13 (3) UPPER HIDDEN BASIN DIVERSION EXPAN-
14 SION.—The term “Upper Hidden Basin Diversion
15 Expansion” means the expansion of the Terror Lake
16 Hydroelectric Project as generally described in Ex-
17 hibit E to the Upper Hidden Basin Grant Applica-
18 tion dated July 2, 2014, and submitted to the Alas-
19 ka Energy Authority Renewable Energy Fund
20 Round VIII by Kodiak Electric Association, Inc.

21 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—The licensee for the Terror
22 Lake Hydroelectric Project may occupy not more than 20
23 acres of Federal land to construct, operate, and maintain
24 the Upper Hidden Basin Diversion Expansion without fur-
25 ther authorization of the Secretary of the Interior or

1 under the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation
2 Act (16 U.S.C. 3101 et seq.).

3 (c) SAVINGS CLAUSE.—The Upper Hidden Basin Di-
4 version Expansion shall be subject to appropriate terms
5 and conditions included in an amendment to a license
6 issued by the Commission pursuant to the Federal Power
7 Act (16 U.S.C. 791a et seq.), including section 4(e) of that
8 Act (16 U.S.C. 797(e)), following an environmental review
9 by the Commission under the National Environmental
10 Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.).
