AN ACT

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Intelligence Rotational Assignment Program in the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “DHS Intelligence Ro-
3 tational Assignment Program Act of 2017”.

4 **SEC. 2. INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-**
5 **GRAM.**

6 Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
7 (6 U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
8 lowing new subsection:

9 “(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-
10 GRAM.—

11 “(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary shall es-
12 tablish an Intelligence Rotational Assignment Pro-
13 gram as part of the Rotation Program under sub-
14 section (a).

15 “(2) ADMINISTRATION.—The Chief Human
16 Capital Officer, in conjunction with the Chief Intel-
17 ligence Officer, shall administer the Intelligence Ro-
18 tational Assignment Program established pursuant
19 to paragraph (1).

20 “(3) ELIGIBILITY.—The Intelligence Rotational
21 Assignment Program established pursuant to para-
22 graph (1) shall be open to employees serving in ex-
23 isting analyst positions within the Department’s In-
24 telligence Enterprise and other Department employ-
25 ees as determined appropriate by the Chief Human
26 Capital Officer and the Chief Intelligence Officer.

1 “(4) COORDINATION.—The responsibilities
2 specified in paragraph (3)(B) of subsection (a) that
3 apply to the Rotation Program under such sub-
4 section shall, as applicable, also apply to the Intel-
5 ligence Rotational Assignment Program under this
6 subsection.”.
