3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “South Carolina Peanut
5 Parity Act of 2017”.

2 **LINA PEANUT PRODUCING REGION.**

3 Section 1308(c)(2)(B)(iii) of the Farm Security and
4 Rural Investment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C.
5 7958(c)(2)(B)(iii)) is amended by striking “Virginia and
6 North Carolina” and inserting “Virginia, North Carolina,
7 and South Carolina”.
