Mr. LAWSON of Florida (for himself, Ms. VELÁZQUEZ, Mr. ESPAILLAT, Ms. ADAMS, Ms. CLARKE of New York, and Mrs. MURPHY of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To codify the Small Business Administration’s Entrepreneurial Education Initiative, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Entrepreneurial Edu-
5 cation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION INITIATIVE.**

7 The Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 et seq.) is
8 amended—

1 (1) by redesignating section 47 as section 48;
2 and

3 (2) by inserting after section 46 the following:

4 **“SEC. 47. ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION INITIATIVE.**

5 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There is established a program
6 within the Small Business Administration to be known as
7 the ‘Entrepreneurial Education Initiative’, under which
8 the Administrator shall provide training to executives of
9 businesses poised for growth in historically challenged
10 communities that have the organizational framework, re-
11 source network, and motivation required to build sustain-
12 able businesses and promote the economic development
13 within urban communities.

14 “(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
15 are authorized to be appropriated to the Administrator
16 such sums as may be necessary to carry out the Entrepre-
17 neurial Education Initiative.”.
