3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Samoa Job
5 Protection & Expansion Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE APPLICABLE TO AMERICAN**
2 **SAMOA.**

3 Section 8103(b)(2) of the Fair Minimum Wage Act
4 of 2007 (29 U.S.C. 206(b)(2) note) is amended by striking
5 subparagraph (B) and inserting the following:

6 “(B) increased thereafter by such amount
7 and at such time as determined by the Sec-
8 retary of Labor through special industry com-
9 mittees as in place prior to July 24, 2007.”.
