## A BILL

To amend the National Labor Relations Act to prohibit  
the preemption of State stalking laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom from Union  
5 Stalking Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS ACT.**

7 The National Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 151  
8 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following  
9 new section:

1       “SEC. 20. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to  
2 preempt a law of any State, territory, or the District of  
3 Columbia that prohibits, criminalizes, or creates a civil  
4 cause of action for stalking, cyberstalking, or harass-  
5 ment.”.
