Mr. KIHUEN (for himself, Mr. MOULTON, Mr. NADLER, Ms. ROSEN, Mr. CICILLINE, Mr. LAMBORN, Mr. WEBER of Texas, and Mr. GOTTHEIMER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To extend quarterly reports on confirmed ballistic missile launches from Iran and imposition of sanctions in connection with those launches.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Iran Ballistic Missile
5 Reporting Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

1 (1) Iran continues to test ballistic missile tech-
2 nology notwithstanding the restrictions imposed
3 under United Nations Security Council Resolution
4 2231 (2015).

5 (2) On January 29, 2017, Iran tested the me-
6 dium-range Khorramshahr ballistic missile that flew
7 600 miles before exploding, in a failed test of a re-
8 entry vehicle.

9 (3) According to press reports, in March 2017
10 Iran tested two short-range Fateh 110 ballistic mis-
11 siles.

12 (4) Iran has inscribed anti-Israel propaganda
13 on its missiles, including “Israel should be wiped off
14 the Earth”.

15 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF QUARTERLY REPORTS ON CON-**
16 **FIRMED BALLISTIC MISSILE LAUNCHES**
17 **FROM IRAN AND IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS**
18 **IN CONNECTION WITH THOSE LAUNCHES.**

19 Section 1226(e) of the National Defense Authoriza-
20 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2017 (Public Law 114–328) is
21 amended by striking “December 31, 2019” and inserting
22 “December 31, 2022”.
