1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 SEC. 2. REPORT ON CYBER VULNERABILITIES.

5 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 240 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland 6 7 Security shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Se-8 curity of the House of Representatives and the Committee 9 on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a report that contains a description of the policies 10 11 and procedures developed for coordinating cyber vulner-12 ability disclosures, in accordance with section 227(m) of 13 the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 148(m)). To the extent possible, such report shall include an annex 14 with information on instances in which such policies and 15 16 procedures were used to disclose cyber vulnerabilities in the year prior to the date such report is required and, 17 18 where available, information on the degree to which such 19 information was acted upon by industry and other stakeholders. Such report may also contain a description of how 20 the Secretary is working with other Federal entities and 21 22 critical infrastructure owners and operators to prevent, de-23 tect, and mitigate cyber vulnerabilities.

(b) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
shall be submitted in unclassified form but may contain
a classified annex.
