- To require the Director of the National Background Investigations Bureau to submit a report on the backlog of personnel security clearance investigations, and for other purposes.

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

5 SEC. 2. REPORT ON BACKLOG OF PERSONNEL SECURITY

- 6 CLEARANCE INVESTIGATIONS.
- 7 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
- 8 of this Act, and quarterly thereafter for 5 years, the Direc-
- 9 tor of the National Background Investigations Bureau of
- 10 the Office of Personnel Management shall submit to Con-
- 11 gress a report on the backlog of security clearance inves-
- 12 tigations that includes—
- 13 (1) the size of the personnel security clearance
- investigation process backlog; and
- 15 (2) the average length of time, for each sensi-
- 16 tivity level, to carry out an initial investigation and
- 17 a periodic investigation.
- 18 SEC. 3. REPORT ON SECURITY CLEARANCE INVESTIGA-
- 19 TIONS OF PERSONNEL OF THE EXECUTIVE
- 20 **OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT.**
- Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
- 22 of this Act, the Director of the National Background In-
- 23 vestigations Bureau of the Office of Personnel Manage-
- 24 ment shall submit to Congress a report that explains the
- 25 process for conducting and adjudicating security clearance

- 1 investigations for personnel of the Executive Office of the
- 2 President, including White House personnel.
- 3 SEC. 4. REPORT ON DUPLICATIVE COSTS.
- 4 Not later than 120 days after the date of enactment
- 5 of this Act, the Director of the National Background In-
- 6 vestigations Bureau of the Office of Personnel Manage-
- 7 ment shall submit to Congress a report on the cost of du-
- 8 plicating resources under the control or direction of the
- 9 National Background Investigations Bureau for imple-
- 10 mentation of the plan referenced in section 951(a)(1) of
- 11 the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
- 12 2017 (10 U.S.C. 1564 note).
