A BILL

To require the Director of the National Background Investigations Bureau to submit a report on the backlog of personnel security clearance investigations, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Securely Expediting
- 5 Clearances Through Reporting Transparency Act of
- 6 2017" or the "SECRET Act of 2017".

SEC. 2. REPORT ON BACKLOG OF PERSONNEL SECURITY 2 CLEARANCE INVESTIGATIONS. 3 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment 4 of this Act, and quarterly thereafter for 5 years, the Direc-5 tor of the National Background Investigations Bureau of the Office of Personnel Management shall submit to Con-6 7 gress a report on the backlog of security clearance investigations that includes— 9 (1) the size of the personnel security clearance 10 investigation process backlog; and (2) the average length of time, for each sensi-11 12 tivity level, to carry out an initial investigation and a periodic investigation. 13
