A BILL

To amend title V of the Social Security Act to reauthorize the Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Home Visiting Works
3 Act of 2017”.

4 **SEC. 2. CONTINUING EVIDENCE-BASED HOME VISITING**
5 **PROGRAM.**

6 Section 511(j)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 711(j)(1)) is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (G), by striking “and”;

9 (2) in subparagraph (H), by striking the period
10 and inserting a semicolon; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(I) for fiscal year 2018, \$600,000,000;

13 “(J) for fiscal year 2019, \$600,000,000;

14 “(K) for fiscal year 2020, \$700,000,000;

15 “(L) for fiscal year 2021, \$700,000,000;

16 and

17 “(M) for fiscal year 2022, \$800,000,000.”.

18 **SEC. 3. RESERVATION FOR INDIAN TRIBES.**

19 Section 511(j)(2)(A) of the Social Security Act (42
20 U.S.C. 711(j)(2)(A)) is amended by striking “3 percent”
21 and inserting “6 percent”.

22 **SEC. 4. EXEMPTION FROM SPENDING REDUCTION.**

23 Section 255(h) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
24 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 255(h)) is
25 amended by inserting after the item relating to “Grants

1 to States for Medicaid (75–0512–0–1–551).” the following

2 new item:

3 “The Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood

4 Home Visiting Program (075–0321).”.
