Mr. RUIZ (for himself, Mr. CARBAJAL, and Mr. KIHUEN) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to expand eligibility for the refundable credit for coverage under a qualified health plan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Affordable Coverage
5 for More Americans Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN ELIGIBILITY FOR CREDIT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (A) of section
8 36B(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amend-
9 ed by striking “400 percent” and inserting “600 percent”.

1 (b) APPLICABLE PERCENTAGES.—The table con-
 2 tained in clause (i) of section 36B(b)(3)(A) of the Internal
 3 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking the period
 4 at the end of the last row and by adding at the end the
 5 following new rows:

“400% up to 550%	9.5%	11%
550% up to 600%	11%	13%”.

6 (c) LIMITATION ON RECAPTURE.—Clause (i) of sec-
 7 tion 36B(f)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
 8 is amended—

9 (1) by striking “400 percent” and inserting
 10 “600 percent”;

11 (2) by striking the period at the end of the last
 12 row of the table; and

13 (3) by adding at the end of the table the fol-
 14 lowing new row:

“At least 400% but less than 600%	\$3,500”.
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15 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 16 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
 17 December 31, 2017.

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
