Mr. FLORES (for himself and Mr. GENE GREEN of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

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## A BILL

To establish an additional fund in the Treasury to reimburse costs incurred by terrestrial radio stations as a result of the reorganization of broadcast television spectrum, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Radio Consumer Pro-  
5 tection Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. RADIO CONSUMER PROTECTION FUND.**

2 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the  
3 Treasury of the United States a fund to be known as the  
4 “Radio Consumer Protection Fund”.

5 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
6 are authorized to be appropriated to the Radio Consumer  
7 Protection Fund such sums as may be necessary to carry  
8 out the purposes of the Radio Consumer Protection Fund.

9 (c) PURPOSES; AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Amounts  
10 in the Radio Consumer Protection Fund shall be available  
11 to the Commission to make any payments to a broadcast  
12 radio station for costs that the station incurred resulting  
13 from the reorganization of broadcast television spectrum  
14 authorized under section 6403(b) of the Middle Class Tax  
15 Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1452(b)).

16 (d) LIMITATION.—Amounts made available to the  
17 Commission under subsection (c) shall be available until  
18 the end of fiscal year 2022.

19 (e) UNUSED FUNDS RETURNED TO THE GENERAL  
20 FUND OF THE TREASURY.—If any amounts remain in the  
21 Radio Consumer Protection Fund after the end of fiscal  
22 year 2022, the Secretary shall transfer such amounts to  
23 the general fund of the Treasury.

24 **SEC. 3. EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS.**

25 The Commission shall expedite consideration and ap-  
26 proval of applications from licensees of broadcast radio

1 stations seeking to obtain special temporary authority to  
2 continue broadcasting during the reorganization of broad-  
3 cast television spectrum authorized under section 6403(b)  
4 of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of  
5 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1452(b)).

6 **SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) **BROADCAST RADIO STATION.**—The term  
9 “broadcast radio station” means any entity that is  
10 licensed by the Commission as an AM, FM, non-  
11 commercial educational FM, or FM Translator radio  
12 broadcast station under the Communications Act of  
13 1934 (47 U.S.C. 151 et seq.).

14 (2) **COMMISSION.**—The term “Commission”  
15 means the Federal Communications Commission.

16 (3) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means  
17 the Secretary of the Treasury.

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
