

***In the Senate of the United States,***

*September 27, 2018.*

*Resolved*, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 4254) entitled “An Act to amend the National Science Foundation Authorization Act of 2002 to strengthen the aerospace workforce pipeline by the promotion of Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program and National Aeronautics and Space Administration internship and fellowship opportunities to women, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

**AMENDMENT:**

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.***

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Women in Aerospace*  
3 *Education Act”.*

4 ***SEC. 2. ROBERT NOYCE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM***

5 ***FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITIES.***

6 *(a) IN GENERAL.—The National Science Foundation*  
7 *Authorization Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–368; 42 U.S.C.*  
8 *1862n et seq.) is amended—*

1           (1) in section 10(a)(3)(A)(iv), by inserting “, in-  
2           cluding research experiences at national laboratories  
3           and NASA centers” before the semicolon; and

4           (2) in section 10A(c)(4)—

5                 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “and”  
6                 at the end;

7                 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking the  
8                 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9                 (C) by adding at the end the following:

10                 “(C) providing internship opportunities for  
11                 fellows, including research experiences at na-  
12                 tional laboratories and NASA Centers.”.

13           (b) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—The amendments made by sub-  
14           section (a) shall apply with respect to grants awarded on  
15           or after October 1, 2018.

16           **SEC. 3. NASA INTERNSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNI-**  
17                 **TIES.**

18           Not later than October 1, 2018, the Administrator of  
19           the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (in  
20           this section referred to as “NASA”) shall institute a process  
21           to encourage the recruitment of qualified candidates who  
22           are women or individuals who are underrepresented in the  
23           fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics  
24           (STEM) and computer science for internships and fellow-
