5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1503 of the Dodd-Frank  
6 Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (15  
7 U.S.C. 78m–2) is hereby repealed.

8 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents  
9 in section 1(b) of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and

1 Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.) is  
2 amended by striking the item relating to section 1503.
