## A BILL

To require the Attorney General to study whether an individual's history of domestic violence can be used to determine the likelihood of such individual committing a mass shooting.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. STUDY ON WHETHER AN INDIVIDUAL'S HIS-**  
4                               **TORY OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CAN BE USED**  
5                               **TO DETERMINE THE LIKELIHOOD OF SUCH**  
6                               **INDIVIDUAL COMMITTING A MASS SHOOTING.**

7       Not later than 12 months after the date of enactment  
8       of this Act, the Attorney General of the United States

1 shall complete a study and submit a report to the Con-  
2 gress on whether an individual's history of domestic vio-  
3 lence can be used to determine the likelihood of such indi-  
4 vidual committing a mass shooting.
