A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to require certain additional budgetary information to be included in the annual report submitted to Congress on the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Missed Opportunities
5 in Veterans Affairs Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS; SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

7 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that the Department
8 of Veterans Affairs was established to assists veterans and

1 provide them with services, as necessary and as Congress
2 sees fit.

3 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
4 gress that—

5 (1) veterans should be provided ample access to
6 the necessary resources that will help them re-
7 integrate as civilians and continue to contribute
8 positively to our society;

9 (2) United States fiscal policy should ensure
10 that there are always adequate resources to provide
11 quality and timely support, services, and care for
12 those who protect and serve the country; and

13 (3) the Department of Veterans Affairs should
14 provide an account of all denied funding that was re-
15 quested to assist veterans programs concerning
16 health care, research, career development, continued
17 education, and for other purposes.

18 **SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL BUDGETARY INFORMATION TO BE IN-**
19 **CLUDED IN ANNUAL REPORT ON DEPART-**
20 **MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

21 Section 529 of title 38, United States Code, is
22 amended—

23 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
24 end;

1 (2) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-
2 graph (4); and

3 (3) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
4 lowing new paragraph (3):

5 “(3) account for any denial of funding for the
6 fiscal year for any construction project of the De-
7 partment of Veterans Affairs or for any program
8 aimed at helping veterans access resources, including
9 health care, career support, resources for homeless
10 veterans, and research on such issues; and”.

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
