Mr. LAWSON of Florida introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations, and in addition to the Committee on the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the Army Corps of Engineers for flood control projects and storm damage reduction projects in areas affected by flooding in the city of Jacksonville, Florida, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018:

1 DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
2 CORPS OF ENGINEERS—CIVIL
3 CONSTRUCTION

4 For an additional amount for “Construction” for
5 flood control projects and storm damage reduction
6 projects in areas affected by flooding in the city of Jack-
7 sonville, Florida, that have received a major disaster dec-
8 laration pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-
9 lief and Emergency Assistance Act, \$116,968,000, to re-
10 main available through fiscal year 2027: *Provided*, That
11 upon approval of the Committees on Appropriations of the
12 House of Representatives and the Senate these funds may
13 be used to construct any project by the Corps for reducing
14 flooding and storm damage risks in the city of Jackson-
15 ville, Florida, that the Secretary determines is technically
16 feasible, economically justified, and environmentally ac-
17 ceptable: *Provided further*, That projects using these funds
18 shall be at full Federal expense with respect to such funds:
19 *Provided further*, That such amount is designated by the
20 Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to section
21 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
22 Deficit Control Act of 1985.

23 This Act may be cited as the “Flood Water Relief
24 Act of 2017”.
