A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit former Members of Congress from lobbying Members, officers, or employees of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Golden Parachutes
5 for Public Service Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST LOBBYING OF CONGRESS**

7 **BY FORMER MEMBERS.**

8 (a) SENATORS.—Section 207(e)(1)(A) of title 18,
9 United States Code, is amended by striking “within 2
10 years”.

1 (b) MEMBERS AND OFFICERS OF THE HOUSE OF
2 REPRESENTATIVES.—Section 207(e)(1)(B)(i) of such title
3 is amended by striking “within 1 year”.

4 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
6 respect to individuals who leave office on or after the date
7 of the enactment of this Act.
