 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hospital Energy Con-
 - 5 servation Act".

- 3 (a) Establishment.—The Secretary of Energy
- 4 shall establish a pilot program to award grants and loan
- 5 guarantees to hospitals to carry out energy conservation
- 6 projects for the purpose of—
- 7 (1) significantly improving the energy efficiency
- 8 of such hospitals; and
- 9 (2) encouraging onsite power generation and
- energy storage, capable of operating independent of
- the grid, and providing sufficient onsite emergency
- backup power for essential hospital functions.
- 13 (b) Number of Hospitals.—The Secretary shall
- 14 award grants and loan guarantees under the pilot program
- 15 to no more than 6 hospitals during the period described
- 16 in subsection (f).
- 17 (c) APPLICATIONS.—A hospital seeking a grant or
- 18 loan guarantee under the pilot program shall submit an
- 19 application to the Secretary at such time, in such manner,
- 20 and accompanied by such information as the Secretary

- 22 (d) Considerations.—In selecting a hospital to
- 23 award a grant or loan guarantee under the pilot program,
- 24 the Secretary shall give special consideration to applica-
- 25 tions from such hospitals that can demonstrate that they

- 3 (e) Definitions.—In this section, the terms "hos-
- 4 pital" and "energy conservation project" have the mean-
- 5 ings given such terms in section 391 of the Energy Policy
- 6 and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6371).
- 7 (f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
- 8 are authorized to be appropriated for carrying out this sec-
- 9 tion such sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 2019
- 10 and 2020, to be derived from funds otherwise authorized
- 11 to be appropriated for related purposes.
