AN ACT

To require the Surface Transportation Board to implement
certain recommendations of the Inspector General of the
Department of Transportation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “STB Information Se-
3 curity Improvement Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Surface Transportation
6 Board (in this section referred to as the “STB”) shall de-
7 velop a timeline and plan to implement the recommenda-
8 tions of the Inspector General of the Department of
9 Transportation in Report No. FI2018002, including im-
10 provements—

11 (1) to identify controls, including risk manage-
12 ment, weakness remediation, and security authoriza-
13 tion;

14 (2) to protect controls, including configuration
15 management, user identity and access management,
16 and security training;

17 (3) to detect controls, including continuous
18 monitoring;

19 (4) to respond controls, including incident han-
20 dling and reporting;

21 (5) to recover controls for contingency planning;
22 and

23 (6) any additional tools that will improve the
24 implementation of the recommendations.

25 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
2 after the date of enactment of this Act, the STB
3 shall submit the plan and timeline developed under
4 subsection (a) to the Committee on Transportation
5 and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives
6 and the Committee on Commerce of the Senate.

7 (2) REPORT.—The STB shall report annually
8 to such Committees on the progress on implementa-
9 tion of the recommendations until the implementa-
10 tion is complete.

11 (3) PLAN IMPLEMENTATION.—The STB shall
12 designate an individual to implement the plan devel-
13 oped under subsection (a).

14 **SEC. 3. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.**

15 No additional funds are authorized to carry out the
16 requirements of this Act. Such requirements shall be car-
17 ried out using amounts otherwise authorized.
