To repeal section 115 of the Clean Air Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Energy Sovereignty
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 115 of the Clean Air Act
8 (42 U.S.C. 7415) is repealed.

9 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
10 110(a)(2)(D)(ii) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
11 7410(a)(2)(D)(ii)) is amended by striking “sections 126
12 and 115 (relating to interstate and international pollution

- 1 abatement)” and inserting “section 126 (relating to inter-
- 2 state pollution abatement)”.
