A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY OF JAMES WELDON**

4 **JOHNSON BIRTHPLACE.**

5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Interior shall con-
6 duct a special resource study to determine the suitability
7 and feasibility of establishing the birthplace of James
8 Weldon Johnson located at Adams & Lee Street in Jack-
9 sonville, Florida, as a unit of the National Park System.

10 (b) STUDY REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary shall
11 conduct the study in accordance with section 100507 of
12 title 54, United States Code.

13 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 3 years after the date
14 on which funds are made available to carry out this Act,
15 the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Natural
16 Resources of the House of Representatives and the Com-
17 mittee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate
18 a report that describes—

19 (1) the results of the study; and

20 (2) any recommendations of the Secretary.
