AN ACT

- To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to require the Department of Homeland Security to develop an engagement strategy with fusion centers, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "DHS Field Engage-3 ment Accountability Act".

4 SEC. 2. ENGAGEMENT STRATEGY WITH FUSION CENTERS.

5 Section 210A of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
6 (6 U.S.C. 124h) is amended by—

7 (1) redesigning subsections (j) and (k) as sub8 sections (k) and (l), respectively; and

9 (2) inserting after subsection (i) the following10 new subsection:

11 "(j) FUSION CENTER INFORMATION SHARING STRATEGY.—Not later than 1 year after the date of the 12 13 enactment of this subsection, the Secretary shall develop and update at least once every 5 years a strategy for De-14 partment engagement with fusion centers. Such strategy 15 16 shall be developed and updated in consultation with the heads of intelligence components of the Department, the 17 18 Chief Privacy Officer of the Department, the Officer for 19 Civil Rights and Civil Liberties of the Department, offi-20cials of fusion centers, officers designated as Homeland 21 Security Advisors, and the heads of other relevant agen-22 cies, as appropriate. Such strategy shall include the fol-23 lowing:

24 "(1) Specific goals and objectives for sharing
25 information and engaging with fusion centers—

| 19 | days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Under |
| 20 | Secretary for Intelligence and Analysis of the Department |

3 SEC. 4. DHS COMPONENT USAGE OF THE HOMELAND SECU4 RITY INFORMATION NETWORK.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Chief Intelligence
7 Officer of the Department of Homeland Security, in con8 sultation with the Chief Information Officer of the Depart9 ment, shall—

(1) develop policies and metrics to ensure effective use by components of the Department of the
Department's unclassified Homeland Security Information Sharing Network, or any successor system;
and

(2) develop policies for posting unclassified
products on the Homeland Security Information
Sharing Network, or any successor system.

18 (b) TECHNICAL ENHANCEMENTS.—The Chief Information Officer of the Department of Homeland Security, 19 in consultation with the Chief Intelligence Officer of the 20 21 Department, shall assess and implement, as appropriate, 22 technical enhancements to the Homeland Security Infor-23 mation Sharing Network (HSIN) to improve usability, in-24 cluding search functionality, data analysis, and collabora-25 tion capabilities.

1 SEC. 5. REPORT.

2 Not later than 18 months after the date of the enact-3 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Security and the 4 5 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Homeland Secu-6 7 rity and Governmental Affairs and the Select Committee 8 on Intelligence of the Senate a report on the implementation of the following: 9

(1) The fusion center information sharing strategy required under subsection (j) of section 210A of
the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C.
12 124h), as added by section 2 of this Act, based on
performance metrics developed pursuant to such
strategy.

16 (2) Field personnel deployed to fusion centers
17 (as such term is defined in section 210A of the
18 Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 124h)) in
19 accordance with section 3, based on performance
20 metrics developed pursuant to such section.

(3) Policies that seek to ensure the effective useof the Homeland Security Information Sharing Net-

work in accordance with section 4, based on the
 metrics developed pursuant to such section.
