A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to include contracts awarded under section 8127 of title 38, United States Code, in the limitations relating to subcontracting, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Business
5 Opportunities for Veterans Adjustment Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO SUBCONTRACTING LIMITATIONS**
2 **IN THE SMALL BUSINESS ACT.**

3 Section 46 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
4 657s) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “or under
6 section 8127 of title 38, United States Code,” after
7 “36,”; and

8 (2) in subsection (e)(1)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (D), by striking “or”
10 at the end;

11 (B) in subparagraph (E), by striking the
12 period at the end and inserting “; or”; and

13 (C) by adding at the end the following new
14 subparagraph:

15 “(F) with respect to a contract awarded
16 under section 8127 of title 38, United States
17 Code, is a small business concern owned and
18 controlled by veterans (as defined in such sec-
19 tion).”.
