## AN ACT

To designate the Quindaro Townsite in Kansas City, Kansas,  
as a National Commemorative Site.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. QUINDARO TOWNSITE NATIONAL COMMEMO-**  
2 **RATIVE SITE ACT.**

3 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This Act may be cited as the  
4 “Quindaro Townsite National Commemorative Site Act”.

5 (b) **DEFINITION.**—In this Act, the term “Secretary”  
6 means the Secretary of the Interior.

7 (c) **DESIGNATION.**—The Quindaro Townsite in Kan-  
8 sas City, Kansas, as listed on the National Register of  
9 Historic Places, is hereby designated as the Quindaro  
10 Townsite National Commemorative Site. The Site shall  
11 not be considered a unit of the National Park System.

12 (d) **ADMINISTRATION.**—Nothing in this section shall  
13 affect the administration of the Quindaro Townsite by  
14 Kansas City or the State of Kansas.

15 (e) **COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.**—The Secretary, in  
16 consultation with the State of Kansas, Kansas City, Kan-  
17 sas, and affected subdivisions, may enter into cooperative  
18 agreements with appropriate public or private entities, for  
19 the purposes of protecting historic resources at Quindaro  
20 Townsite and providing educational and interpretive pro-  
21 grams for the public.

22 (f) **TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.**—The Secretary may  
23 provide technical assistance to any entity with which the  
24 Secretary has entered into a cooperative agreement under  
25 subsection (e).

1 (g) EFFECT ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, LOCAL LAND  
2 USE, AND LAND ACQUISITION AUTHORITY.—Nothing in  
3 this Act authorizes the Secretary to—

4 (1) interfere with private property rights, or  
5 any local zoning ordinance or land use plan of the  
6 State or any political subdivision of the State; or

7 (2) acquire land or interests in land through  
8 condemnation or otherwise.
