A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to require prescription drug plan sponsors under the Medicare program to establish drug management programs for at-risk beneficiaries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIRING PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN SPON-**
2 **SORS UNDER MEDICARE TO ESTABLISH**
3 **DRUG MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS FOR AT-**
4 **RISK BENEFICIARIES.**

5 Section 1860D–4(c) of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 1395w–104(c)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting after sub-
8 paragraph (E) the following new subparagraph:

9 “(F) With respect to plan years beginning
10 on or after January 1, 2021, a drug manage-
11 ment program for at-risk beneficiaries described
12 in paragraph (5).”; and

13 (2) in paragraph (5)(A), by inserting “(and for
14 plan years beginning on or after January 1, 2021,
15 a PDP sponsor shall)” after “A PDP sponsor may”.

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
