A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR CERTAIN
- 4 STUDIES BY THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUN-
- 5 DATION.
- 6 No Federal funds may be used by the National
- 7 Science Foundation to conduct a study on—

1	(1) how Members of Congress set priorities
2	within the constraints of the contemporary legisla-
3	ture;

- (2) the relationships between Members of Congress with respect to the sharing of guidance and informative documents; or
- (3) the impact of such guidance and informative documents, including dear colleague letters, sent between Members of Congress.
