A BILL

To designate the J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and Courthouse in Amarillo, Texas, as the “J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and Mary Lou Robinson United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and Court-
5 house located at 205 SE 5th Ave., Amarillo, Texas, shall
6 be known and designated as the “J. Marvin Jones Federal
7 Building and Mary Lou Robinson United States Court-
8 house”.

9 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

10 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
11 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
12 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
13 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “J. Marvin
14 Jones Federal Building and Mary Lou Robinson United
15 States Courthouse”.

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
