A BILL

To provide that Executive Order 13768 (82 Fed. Reg. 8799; entitled “Enhancing Public Safety in the Interior of the United States”), shall have no force or effect, to prohibit the use of Federal funds to enforce the Executive Order, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Trust Act
5 of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXECUTIVE ORDER TO HAVE NO FORCE OR EFFECT.**

2 Beginning on January 25, 2017, Executive Order
3 13768 (82 Fed. Reg. 8799; entitled “Enhancing Public
4 Safety in the Interior of the United States”), is null and
5 void, shall have no force or effect, and may not be imple-
6 mented, administered, enforced, or carried out.

7 **SEC. 3. NO FUNDS AVAILABLE.**

8 No Federal funds (including fees) made available for
9 any fiscal year, may be used to implement, administer, en-
10 force, or carry out (including through the issuance of any
11 regulations) any of the policy changes set forth in Execu-
12 tive Order 13768 (82 Fed. Reg. 8799; entitled “Enhanc-
13 ing Public Safety in the Interior of the United States”).

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
