Mr. COLLINS of Georgia, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 372) to restore the application of the Federal antitrust laws to the business of health insurance to protect competition and consumers.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 372) to restore the application of the Federal antitrust
4 laws to the business of health insurance to protect com-
5 petition and consumers. All points of order against consid-

1 eration of the bill are waived. In lieu of the amendment
2 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-
3 mittee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill, an amend-
4 ment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text
5 of Rules Committee Print 115-8 shall be considered as
6 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
7 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
8 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
9 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
10 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening
11 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
12 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
13 the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to
14 recommit with or without instructions.

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
