Ms. BLUNT ROCHESTER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to prohibit the consideration of any general appropriations bill until a concurrent resolution on the budget has been adopted or the appropriate budgetary suballocations are made available.

1 *Resolved*, Clause 2 of rule XXI of the Rules of the
2 House of Representatives is amended by adding at the end
3 the following new paragraph:

4 “(h) It shall not be in order in the House to consider
5 a general appropriations bill for a fiscal year unless the
6 Committee on Appropriations has filed the allocations re-
7 quired by section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act

1 of 1974, or, if a concurrent resolution on the budget has
2 not yet been agreed to for that fiscal year, unless the Com-
3 mittee on Appropriations has filed a report indicating the
4 total amount of new discretionary budget authority it in-
5 tends to include in general appropriations bills for the fis-
6 cal year and how it has allocated that total among its sub-
7 committees.”.
